Governor lauds corporate sector's CSR activities

Governor Punjab Sardar Latif Khan Khosa has lauded the role of corporate sector for their outstanding role in discharging corporate social responsibility for the uplift of the people of Pakistan.

He was addressing the participants of 4th International Summit on "Corporate Social Responsibility" and Business Excellence Awards 2012 organized by National Forum for Environment & Health (NFEH) in collaboration with United Nations Environmental Program (UNEP) in Lahore.

The Governor said that the corporate sector was providing services and relief in various fields of life to improve the lot of the poor people in the country. "The corporate sector is a real strength of the government as it could not alone cope with the challenge to meet the demands of the people," he added.

He praised the corporate sector and entrepreneurs for their contribution in the development of the country and service to the welfare of people in the country. He especially eulogized the efforts of corporate sector, which had reached out and helped the people during the natural calamities of earthquake of 2005 and floods of 2010. He emphasized the need to display the same resilience and unity to counter the menaces of power crisis, terrorism, poverty and illiteracy.

He called upon all political parties to shun politics of blame-game and adopt pragmatic approach and start concerted efforts by involving all stakeholders to resolve the issue of energy and power crisis in the country.

Sardar Latif Khosa also linked continuation of democratic system to the solution to problems like energy and power crisis, poverty, terrorism and illiteracy. He said that PPP government led by Mohtarma Benazir Bhutto in 1996 had taken the power production to 19,500 MW, which was surplus to the needs of even today and were planning to export electricity to the other countries. "The plan was launched to take power generation to 40,000 MW," he added.
